a) Strategic Plan 2016-2018 Annual Review

Mayor Moore advised that the Committee-Of-The-Whole meeting is being held to discuss the corporate strategic plan for 2016-2018.

Discussion ensued, and Council suggested the following:

- That funding for an Inflow and Infiltration Program should be committed / designating funds for future initiatives;
- That it would be beneficial to determine a maximum debt to property tax ratio in order to help guide future capital investment and borrowing requirements for the City;
- That opportunities for senior government grant funding, as well as a complete list of grants the City applied for, including grant details, should be provided to Council;
- That it would be beneficial to receive data on all city facilities prior to making major investment decisions;
- That increasing Council's physical presence within the community could improve communication and public engagement;
- That opportunities to improve communication within the City be explored;
- That implementing affordable access to regional recreation amenities could be a lower priority, given the feedback from the previous public input sessions;
- That the midtown transition area be reviewed, including the completion of a plan and/or future concepts;
- That service levels be adjusted to be more cost efficient for users; and,
- That Administration be provided with priorities in order to give direction for implementation.

Council reviewed a document provided by Councillor Zwicker.
