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The Acting Chair called the Public Hearing to order at 7:00 p.m.

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The Acting Chair stated that this Public Hearing is being convened pursuant to Section 890 of the Local Government Act and is intended to consider the proposed Bylaw No. 2558, 2013(4) - Zoning Amendment Bylaw for the property zoned MA-1 located in the upper areas for the Red Mountain Ski Resort, legally identified as DL 640, Kootenay District, PID 017-012-937 be rezoned to CD-1.

She stated that any person present, who believes that his or her interest is affected by the proposed bylaw, shall be given an opportunity to express their views and concerns with regard to Bylaw No. 2558. She added that those who wished to speak should commence their address by clearly stating their name and address, prior to presenting their views concerning the bylaw.

The Acting Chair advised that Members of Council could ask questions of the presenters; however, she stated that the purpose of the hearing is not to argue the merits of the bylaw, but rather to listen to any presentations that anyone may wish to make regarding the proposed bylaw. She went on to advise that a summary of these proceedings would be recorded and presented to the Council.

She requested that those in attendance refrain from applause or other expressions of emotion, as this enables others whose views maybe different to exercise their right to express their views.

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**Bylaw No. 2558, 2013(4)**

The Acting Corporate Officer advised that a notice was published in the October 17<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>, 2013 editions of the Rossland News, posted on the City bulletin board and web site since October 16<sup>th</sup>, 2013, and that staff mailed all owners and residents within 100m of

the proposed rezoning with notice of the proposed bylaw as required by City Bylaw and the *Local Government Act*. The City has not received any written submissions regarding this application.
