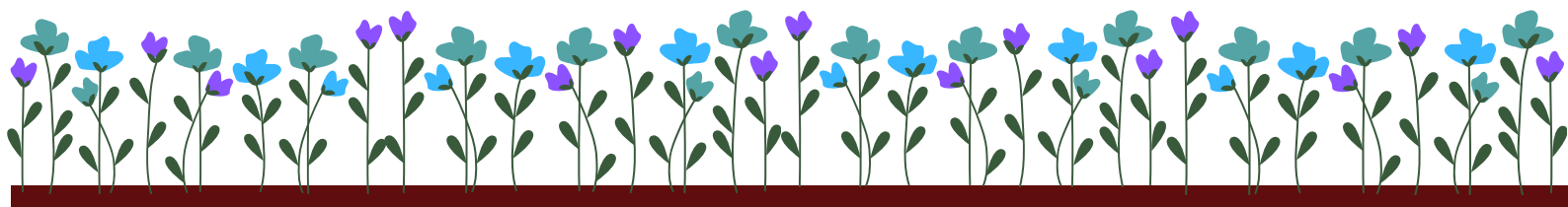


Meet your Water Smart Ambassador Kai Symington-Kruus

BOOK YOUR FREE LAWN AND GARDEN ASSESSMENT TODAY!

A lawn or Garden Assessment will take approximately 30 minutes and includes a soil sample, as well as, an assessment of your garden or lawn watering needs. The Water Smart Ambassador can also help suggest specific landscaping needs or plants that can assist with outdoor water conservation.

When you book a lawn assessment you will receive a free hose timer and be entered to win 1 of 3 drip irrigation kits.

STAGE ONE: Year-round restrictions unless otherwise posted

Alternate day watering based on residential house number (odd/even)

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Washing of vehicles, boats & motorized equipment • Washing outdoor surfaces • Residential hot tub & pool filling 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Decorative hanging baskets/containers • New landscaping & repairs 	ONLY between 4:00 a.m. & 6:00 a.m. 9:00 p.m. & 11:00 p.m.

Please be aware that there have been recent changes to the City's outdoor water use regulations. Please check the appropriate times to water lawns and landscaping as outlined by the City's Outdoor Water Use Regulation Bylaw No. 2696.

By calculating your household water footprint, you can identify where water conservation is most needed in your household and bring awareness to the quantity of water used by your household every day.

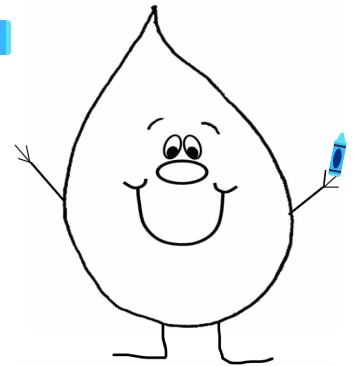

Some Water Conservation Tips!



Water When It's Cooler - to avoid most water evaporation try watering in the morning or in the evening



Sprinkler Set Up - make sure you place your sprinkler in an area where it is watering what needs to be watered and not the sidewalk or street



Check the Weather - if rain is in the forecast, turn off your irrigation system or use a rain sensor to turn off automatic systems



Use Drip Irrigation - this is the best type of irrigation system as water goes directly to the plants



Don't Let your Hose Run - use a hose timer or invest in a squeeze nozzle so you don't have to remember to turn off the water from the tap.
