Assent Voting

'Do you assent to the Regional District of Kootenay Boundary disposing of those portions of the sewer service infrastructure that are located within the City of Rossland and that portion of the sewer service infrastructure located between the boundary of the City of Rossland and the boundary of the Village of Warfield, to the City of Rossland?'

General Voting Day

General Voting Day will be open to qualified electors of the City of Rossland on Saturday, October 20, 2018 between the hours of 8:00 am and 8:00 p.m. at the Miners' Union Hall, 1765 Columbia Avenue, Rossland, B.C.

Advance Voting Opportunities

Advance voting will be open at the **Rossland City Hall**, 2196 Leroi Avenue on Wednesday, **October 10, 2018** and on Wednesday, **October 17, 2018** between the hours of 8:00 am and 8:00 p.m. each day. **Only registered electors will be eligible to participate in advance voting.**

Elector Registration

If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place **on general voting day only**. To register you must meet the following qualifications:

- 18 years of age or older
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding voting day
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in the City of Rossland for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day, and
- not otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

Resident electors and non-resident property electors will also be required to produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.
