## **Centennial Park Wetland Restoration Project Notification**

Construction Dates:
Wednesday August 17 to Saturday August 27, 2016
7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. daily

## \*Please be safe and stay clear of the flagged off areas during these dates!\*

As part of the Centennial Wetland Restoration Project, there will be construction of a new trail between August 17 and 22. This project will run from the Advanced Bike Skills Park along the south Centennial Park Baseball Field fence line to the Rossland Lions Community Campground (just below campsite site #7). This is being built to accommodate hikers, bikers and Off Highway Vehicles (OHV) up to 50 inches wide.

The wetland restoration construction is to repair compaction and channelling caused by infill, the trail route and motorized OHV damage in the wetland. Construction will be between August 24 & 27 in the area south of the Lion's campsite between sites #3 & #4 and below the Ball Field to the Advanced Skills Park area. If you would like to take a look at the wetland restoration construction occurring between August 24-27, the new trail will provide a good viewing spot!
