Subject: Dust Sampling Program and Related Temporary Kootenay Columbia Area Trail Closures

As part of Teck's ongoing program to conduct geotechnical and human health assessments of the lands in the Rosland area associated with historical mine workings, sampling to determine metals content in dust generated through recreational activity will be conducted on Kootenay Columbia area trails during the week of August 28, 2017, between 8 am and 4:30 pm.

To ensure the integrity of the sampling procedures and the safety of personnel conducting this work, small sections of the following trails on land owned by Teck will be closed for 10 to 45-minute periods during this time. The trails are listed in the order of the sampling work, which will be conducted one trail at a time:

- Monte Christo
- Snake
- Yellow Submarine
- Centennial
- Roger's
- Kootenay Columbia Road
- Kootenay Columbia Ridge
- Green Door
- Cemetery
- Spring Cleaning
- Back of Kootenay Columbia
- Sudden Exposure

The closures will be marked with signage and are inclusive of all recreational trail usage, including mountain biking, hiking and walking. We thank everyone for their cooperation in respecting these closures and we apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

The results of the sampling will be used to determine if any remediation is required to maintain safe use.

We recognize the value to the community that the trail system offers and we allow non-motorized, recreational use of designated, authorized trails on many of our lands, in partnership with the Kootenay Columbia Trails Society.
