FALL CLEAN UP

Public Works will be picking up organic material starting **October 29th**.

The City will be driving by each residence once- please ensure all items are on the boulevard by 7:00 am on October 29th.

Any items placed on boulevard after October 29th will **NOT** be picked up and the home owner will be responsible for taking it to the landfill.

Tree Trimmings: Must be under 10 cm in diameter and 3 m length. Piles can be no larger than 1.2 meters in diameter and a limit to a **maximum of 3 piles** per residence. Please bundle branches and place on unmaintained boulevard so our loader will be able to easily access your well bound pile.
(Any larger branches must be taken to the landfill in Trail)

Yard Waste: Leaves and grass clipping **ONLY**. (Absolutely no tree trimmings, dirt, sod, garden waste, rocks, etc.) We would prefer piles to be **placed on tarps** on the boulevard or you may use clear plastic bag not weighing more than 20 lbs/9kg. The City is not responsible to any damage to tarps.
Any overweight bags will be left on the boulevard and reported to Public Works.

NOTE: Items are picked up with a front end loader so please do not place items on manicured boulevards to prevent boulevard damage.

The City of Rossland will pick up only the items listed. It will be the owner's responsibility to take all other refuse to the appropriate recycling facilities or the landfill site.

WINTER IS ON ITS WAY...

Please ensure all alleys and boulevards are clear of vehicles / trailers / campers / rocks / wood piles or any other items that could damage snow removal equipment to prepare for winter snow removal.

We will be tagging / ticketing any vehicles / items that are not moved off of the boulevard by the end of October.

WATCH: for “**No Parking Snow Removal**” signs and have vehicles removed from street before 6am.

Temporary shelters/garages **MUST** be behind your property line and **NOT** on City boulevards or streets.

REMEMBER: Vehicles **MUST** be moved on city streets every 24 hours.

The City crews appreciate the effort put in by all residents to keep the boulevards clear and thank you for removing vehicles from the street when you know the plow is coming around.
