Project Summary: Rossland Miners Union Hall Renovation & Restoration

The City of Rossland and the Rossland Council for Arts & Culture are working together to restore and renovate the Rossland Miners Union Hall for use by all community members.

The City of Rossland is the lead on the exterior restoration and preservation work which includes replacing the leaking roof, replacing and painting damaged siding, removing the crumbling brick chimney and restoring heritage features of the façade.

The Rossland Arts Council is the lead on the interior work which focuses on the renovation of the currently undeveloped Attic (4th Floor) into gathering places for the community.
