Public Works Staff will be picking up organic material beginning the week of April 23, 2019. Please ensure all items are on the boulevard by 7:00 am

The City will begin pick-up at Redstone, then Lower Rossland, Pinewood, Upper Rossland then finishing in the Red Mountain area. The City will be driving by each residence ONCE.

Tree Trimmings

MUST be under 10cm in diameter and 3m in length and placed on an unmaintained boulevard so our loader will be able to easily access your pile. PLEASE DO NOT BUNDLE PILES.

Yard Waste

ONLY leaves and grass clippings can be placed in a pile on your unmaintained boulevard. PLEASE DO NOT BAG YARD WASTE OR MIX WITH TRIMMINGS AND/OR GRAVEL & SAND.

Gravel & Sand

Please rake gravel and sand onto asphalt surface. PLEASE DO NOT MAKE PILES.

The City of Rossland will pick up only the items listed above. It will be the owner's responsibility to take all other refuse to the appropriate recycling facilities or the landfill site.



WATER MAIN FLUSHING

The City of Rossland will commence its water main flushing program on June 3rd, 2019 and will last approximately 4 weeks.

Regular flushing is an important component of a comprehensive water management program and is a requirement of the Ministry of Health.

If you experience dirty water during this period, leave a cold water tap running until the water clears. If dirty water persists after 10 minutes, or if you have any questions, please contact the Public Works office at (250) 362-2328.
