

What's the Heritage Management Plan?

- A Heritage Management Plan uses community input to create a vision and strategies for the conservation of a community's heritage in the short and long term
- Heritage can mean different things to different people. It can include buildings, groups of buildings, sites, landscapes, views, industrial or agricultural features, natural features, roads, trails, spiritual places, events, stories and memories ... anything a community identifies as having heritage value
- The plan takes into account all of the features that a community thinks have heritage value, states why they are important, and uses this information to create actions for heritage conservation
- The Heritage Management Plan is being guided by an 11-member Steering Committee made up of Rossland residents

What's the Heritage Workshop about?

- This focus of the workshop is to collect the community's ideas to understand what the heritage of Rossland is all about, it's places that matter, and the future of its heritage resources
- Building on the important work already done by the community of Rossland, we'll use this information to create strategies and tools for heritage protection and management
- We'll ask the public to respond to questions, map important places and fill out a questionnaire
- All collected input will be considered in the preparation of the Heritage Management Plan
- We want to hear from as many different people in the community as possible
- It's a drop-in format, so stay for as long or short a time as you like
- Light refreshments will be available
