Rossland Recreational Task Force

The key purpose of the Rossland Recreational Task Force is to act in an advisory capacity to City Council on the effects, impacts and issues related to recreation amenities pertaining to the community of Rossland and its residents, as well as to put forth recommendations for Rossland City Council to consider. The Task Force shall strive to have balanced views regarding supporting and opposing tax allocations for recreation. The Task Force shall strive to include members who support providing financial support for regional recreational facilities as well as those who do not.

The Task force shall consist of three (3) current members of Council appointed to the City's Regional Recreation Committee, one (1) representative of Tourism Rossland, one (1) representative of City Staff, and up to 5-7 citizens with differing perspectives and relevant experience such as: recreational user, parent of active youth, senior, and/or recreation background.

Interested parties shall submit a written application, listing their experience and reasons for wanting to participate in the Task Force. All members will be appointed by Mayor and Council, and the Chair will ultimately be appointed by the Task Force members.

Meetings will be scheduled monthly at the discretion of the Chair or upon the request of the majority of members.
