Regular business

1. Fall Fair Display

- another successful event for the Commission as it was of interest to the community. Thanks to the Commission members for set-up and take down and manning the exhibit during the Fall Fair. *We now have a permanent display of pictures with address captions of Rossland's heritage sites and buildings. (Missing the pictures of the two cemeteries).

- 2. Signage for the Columbia Cemetery
 - a) New entrance sign approved by Commission
 - b) Text for kiosk signage submitted to Interior Signs
 - c) Proofing of signs this week by Jackie then signs will be produced and stored at Interior Signs until needed.
- 3. "Early Cemeteries of Rossland" booklet
